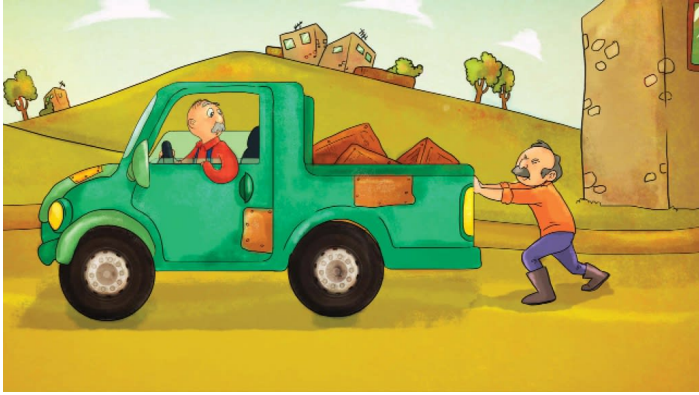




Uncle Lou got in his car, but now it won't go. He needs someone to push it.
